

## Botox for Migraine discoverer, Dr. William J. Binder, discusses treatment with Head and Neck Surgeons

William J. Binder M.D., F.A.C.S. Inc., Beverly Hills plastic surgeon who discovered the BOTOX® for Migraine Treatment, outlined the procedure for the 2010 annual gathering of the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery (AAO-HNSF) in Boston. Dr. Binder, an early pioneer of the cosmetic (anti-wrinkle) use of Botox, made headlines in the early 1990's by discovering that BOTOX was effective in relieving the pain and preventing the onset of migraine headaches. In addition to the American Board of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Dr. Binder is also certified by the American Board of Otolaryngology and Head and Neck Surgery and is is Assistant Clinical Professor, Dept. of Head and Neck Surgery at the UCLA School of Medicine.
